FACT SHEET

PMI Manitoba is proud to recognize, honour and publicize the successful completion of projects in Manitoba whose team members have demonstrated superior performance in the application of project management principles and techniques.

Why should you submit?

The benefits to the organizations which apply for the POY:

- A great way to thank your team for a job well done
- A great way to celebrate project success!
- Let's your organization know that your project was also recognized as a success - externally by a respected professional organization
- Promote understanding of the principles and benefits of project management within your organization
- Increased visibility (with indirect benefits of attracting and keeping staff and clients) throughout your organization and the Manitoba business community
- Publicity – coverage of event by local media
- No charge to submit your entry!
- Looks good on your resume!
- Take your career to the next level!
- Awards – all project submissions will be recognized at a chapter event and receive an award, additionally, the **winner** will receive:
 - Dinner for their project team at 529 Wellington (gift certificate for \$1,000) - complete with limousine service within Winnipeg to make the event extra special! (Note - if winner is from outside of Winnipeg, alternate arrangements will be made for the same value.)
 - 2 one-day PMI Manitoba Conference/Workshop passes - approximate value \$1,100.
 - Professional photograph of the winning project team and the POY 2008 trophy (Photograph to be published in the Winnipeg Free Press)

Eligibility:

All project types, sizes, duration and sectors are encouraged to participate and compete:

- Projects are largely “Made in Manitoba”
- The project must be complete at the time of nomination and accepted as complete by the Owner/Client prior to nomination
- The Owner/Client must approve disclosure of project information
- All professional associations are invited to encourage participation.
- PMI affiliation is not necessary

Evaluation Criteria:

- Met or exceeded Owner/Client's needs as evidenced by a letter from the Owner/Client
- Demonstrated effective application of the principles set forth in A Guide to the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK® Guide)
- Met or improved on scope, budget and/or schedule performance
- Original or innovative application of project management techniques

KEY Dates:

- **Information Session:** forum to provide information and answer questions - mid-November, 2007
- **Expression of Interest:** letter or email indicating your intent to submit your project - November 30th, 2007
- **Submission Deadline:** January 17th, 2008
- **Announcement of Winner/Runner-up(s):** announced at the February 19th, 2008 Chapter Meeting
- **2008 Project of the Year Winner** - option to present your winning project at a Fall 2008 Chapter Meeting
